Brief history ▶	RIS Swiss Section, also called Deutschsprachige Schule Bangkok (DsSB), is the only school in Bangkok using German as the medium of instruction. Established in 1963 as an official Swiss School Abroad, it is also accredited by the Federal Republic of Germany and Thailand. Its high school diploma (Swiss Maturity) is recognised by all universities worldwide and guarantees graduates automatic enrolment at all universities in Switzerland. Furthermore, the diploma provides graduates with a good chance to receive scholarships in Switzerland. RIS Swiss Section follows the Swiss National Curriculum. The school only employs qualified and experienced teaching staff holding master's degrees in education, mainly from universities in Switzerland and Germany. The methodology employed is modern with student centred teaching approaches. Some 240 students are taught by 39 teachers, ensuring an excellent student-teacher ratio of 6:1.
